Franklin, Hopkins and King CDC Preschools



With three preschool campuses, our mission is to create a safe. nurturing environment where all children are supported in their development of academic excellence, emotional security, healthy living and self-expression.

Eligibility

We are one of the state-subsidized programs in Alameda County. Eliqibility is based on factors determined by the State including: income, family size, and other needs. Classroom placement is dependent on eliqibility.





Our classrooms provide learning spaces in racially integrated, linguistically diverse, inclusive environments. Children are encouraged to explore materials as well as relationships with peers that support their unique learning experiences.







Our classroom environments are warm, colorful and inviting with areas carefully designed to be safe and encourage play and learning in all developmental areas following the CA Preschool Learning Foundations, Creative Curriculum, and Project Based Learning. We also utilize Second Step to support social-emotional learning and development.

We have full day and part day classrooms, 3 to 6.5 hours per day. In addition, we have general education, Spanish bilingual, inclusion and integrated classrooms in our program.


Integrated Classrooms: 15 students (7 general education children and 8 children with IEPs from BUSD) and one Special Education credentialed teacher and two Special Education Instructional Assistants

General Education Classrooms: 24 students and 3 staff (one Early Childhood Education teacher and two Instructional assistants)

Inclusion Classrooms: 24 students (2 -3 children with IEPs from BUSD) and 3 staff (one Early Childhood Education teacher, two Instructional assistants), and additional individualized support from special education staff such as a special education teacher instructional assistant

Spanish Bilingual Program @ Franklin Preschool: 24 students and 3 staff (one Early Childhood Education teacher and two Instructional assistants) - Two Part day class (3 hours) and Full day class (6.5 hours)





Classroom Newsletters are sent home to share about what is happening in the classroom and within our preschool community.

Parent/Teacher conferences are offered twice a year to focus on the individual progress of children.

There are opportunities for parents to volunteer based on time of year and program need.

Desired Results Developmental Profile, DRDP, is the State required assessment we use twice a year to see how children are progressing in different domains.

The Teaching Team



Our teaching staff is the heart of our program. We believe the role of the teacher is to nurture young children's learning in all aspects of development, empower families and respect the cultural and linguistic diversity and unique characteristics of our preschool community.

The Teaching Team

Our teaching staff is culturally diverse. Many teachers and instructional assistants are bilingual and have many years of experience teaching preschool-aged children.

The teaching staff participate in at least 5 days of Professional Development trainings each year provided by the District to meet State and Licensing requirements as well as support continued learning on current topics in early childhood education.


Our outdoor spaces support active play with opportunities for big movements, construction, dramatic play and interaction with nature.

- Rt1²: Response to Instruction and Intervention is a data-driven, multi-tiered approach that BUSD practices to support ALL students, including those who demonstrate learning and behavioral challenges. <u>Click here for more</u> information
 - Tier 2 Coach: full time support teacher that consults with all teachers and provides small group and individual pre-academic intervention to students
 - Mental Health Consultant: provides classroom consultation and staff/parent support for our children and families; facilitates individual and group play therapy and social skills support
 - Developmental Screenings: we utilize parent-completed questionnaires called the Ages & Stages Questionnaire (ASQ) and the Ages and Stages Questionnaire - Social Emotional (ASQ:SE) to help identify any specific questions about your child's development and/or any needs
- Head Start/Family Advocate: BUSD partners with the Head Start program
 and provides a Family Advocate at each site to support children and
 families to receive health and dental services, nutritious meals and
 resources, family services, and specialized education services for children
 with special needs
- Parent workshops
- Opportunity to be on School Site Council (Parent Group)
- Vision and Hearing screenings provided once per school year




