Optional Deeper Dive

- Identify existing reparations policy or proposal and determine:
 - What is the harm that the policy is responding to?
 - What is the scope of the policy (i.e., who is eligible to receive reparations)?
 - How is the policy funded?

Co-Chairs Discussion
