


The District's General Fund \$213 Million How is the District funded?








BERRA Measure E of 2020

Recruitment, Retention and Development - 5% of available revenues are allocated to BUSD programs designed to recruit staff for hard-to-fill positions such as Special Education, STEM, and increase staff development and pathways.

95% of available revenues allocated to educator compensation.

Advisory Committee Purpose, Roles and Responsibilities



Advisory committees serve the Berkeley Unified School District in an *advisory* capacity on matters pertaining to various aspects of the district plans and budgets in collaboration with district staff and other committee members. The scope of which varies depending on committee (see <u>District Training</u> Committee Resource Website)

- Liaison and represent your school communities, etc on the committees + provide info to SSC and site
- Focus on advisement and collaboration with district staff
- Review and monitor implementation of respective plans, budget and implementation/impact metrics
- → Provide recommendations (to principals, district staff, and/or the Superintendent), as appropriate

Planning and Oversight Committee

P&O - 24 members/24 alternates: Elected by each school's School Site Council (SSC) per measure language:


"A district-wide Planning and Oversight Committee, composed of parents/guardians, staff members, students, residents, or community members representing all school sites and designated programs, shall be established to be advisory to the District, and, in accordance with bylaws adopted by the Board, shall:

- present recommendations to the Board about the annual expenditure plans for the revenues generated by this Measure;
- provide communication among school sites to enhance their effective use of the revenues provided by this Measure; (BSEP)
- and review district compliance with the terms of this Measure."



BERKELEY PUBLIC SCHOOLS **EDUCATIONAL EXCELLENCE ACT OF 2024**

To continue high-quality public education, provide support for struggling students, attract and retain quality teachers, keep school libraries open, support music/ arts programs, and other designated purposes, shall Berkeley Unified School District renew its expiring special tax at \$0.54/ building square foot or \$25/unimproved parcel, with annual adjustments, low-income exemptions, independent citizen/ auditor oversight, generating approximately \$44,000,000 annually in local funds for Berkeley public schools for 8 years that cannot be taken by the State?

Section 9. Definitions

A. "Available Revenues" shall mean the amount of money resulting from the levy of this Special Tax authorized by this Measure after deduction of authorized charges for services provided by the County of Alameda and the City of Berkeley for the preparation and collection of the tax, legal and audit fees, and less two percent (2%) two and a half percent (2.5%) of the remaining revenues which shall be dedicated to support of the Planning and Oversight Committee, School Site Councils and Community Engagement, and for communications and public information services.
