7:13pm	Icebreaker (cont.)	 Representative: I feel like I can never quite grasp the big picture. I like pie charts and graphs. Dir. Estupin: The budget is here:
7:17pm	PAC Feedback Presentation	 Co-Chair Nofelt: PAC makes recommendations each year and staff provides a response based upon that feedback. The district proposes next steps. We need to make recommendations based upon the staff update, this will hopefully help us understand our impact. Dir. Estupin: The words can be pretty small due to the fact there is a lot of information. Dir. Estupin: The doc shows PAC recommendations on any line that has a "P", we consolidated all of our recommendations with DELAC. Dir. Estupin: The doc shows first recommendations from PAC. Co-Chair Nofelt: Our update is within column I on this spreadsheet.

- Representative: Why are there only 3 goals here?
 - Co-Chair Nofelt: We only addressed three goals within our feedback. Goal 5 didn't exist when we were creating our feedback and Goal 4 is about BREA.
 BREA is interwoven within our comments.
 - Dir. Estupin: Can someone give an overview on why you decided to only focus on three?
 - Representative: We created breakout groups and wanted to focus on Goals 1-3. In previous years we decided that these needed more clarification and attention. We went to our sites to collect feedback.
 - Representative: A lot of the information was about how we take the data coming from BREA and use the data more meaningfully to allocate dollars.
 - Representative: One of the things we kept saying, [PAC] keeps making recommendations and we want to be heard and see how recommendations and actions are being taken.
- Dir. Estupin: This was submitted to the board and to the district leadership. Legally, we have to formally respond to the recommendations of the Parent Advisory Committee.
 - Dir. Estupin: These are actions that PAC decided to form recommendations on last year.
 - Dir. Estupin: If you would like, you can always reference our LCAP on our website.
- 1.1: Identify what information BUSD is collecting and how it specifically relates to measuring the impact of each action/program.
 - Dir. Estupin: 2.5 years ago, we did not have a central place where data was consolidated. This response is directly from the department responsible with this action.
 - Dir. Estupin: In January 2023, we launched Educlimber. It has been helpful for us to gather data and carry it and analyze various programs. There are a multitude of ways to use Educlimber to obtain and parse data.
 - Dir. Estupin: One thing to note: The next step is to develop qualitative data systems. This is not currently included within the Educlimber system.
 - o Dir. Estupin: There are data newsletters available on our website.
 - Representative: On the spreadsheet, it says that interventions are within Educlimber. Is that correct?
 - Dir. Estupin: Yes. These are tagged within Educlimber to know that students are

		 Representative: Is there a way to create a shortcut to this on our own Drive? Dir. Estupin: You can download it. 1.2: Clarify what strategies BUSD will use in response to the possible outcomes of data analysis Dir. Estupin: There are two types of data being utilized: screening data and summative data. (Examples: DIBELS, STAR, ELPAC, etc.) Dir. Estupin: What is missing is formative assessments. Data for actions within the classroom, we are working on that now. It's useful when teachers are able to share.
