



Personnel Commissioner Sought

The Personnel Commission of the Berkeley Unified School District is accepting applications for appointment to the Personnel Commission.

Berkeley Unified School District is interested in offering this opportunity to community members in the spirit of open competition. The position of the third commissioner, to be chosen by Berkeley Council of Classified Employees, AFT Local 6192, (BCCE), is vacant.

The Personnel Commission is responsible for the administration of the Merit System for the selection of, and other matters relating to, non-teaching employees of the Berkeley Unified School District. The Commission is composed of three members, each appointed for a three-year term; commissioners may be reappointed. Commissioners normally meet once per month for approximately one hour each meeting and perform a valuable community service, with remuneration of \$50 per meeting.

To qualify, an applicant must be:

- (1) A registered voter and resident of Berkeley, and**
- (2) A known adherent to the principle of the Merit System.**
A known adherent of the merit system shall mean a person, who by the demonstration of his/her prior public or private service, has given evidence that he/she has experience directing or governing sound personnel practices that actively support the concept of the merit system.
