

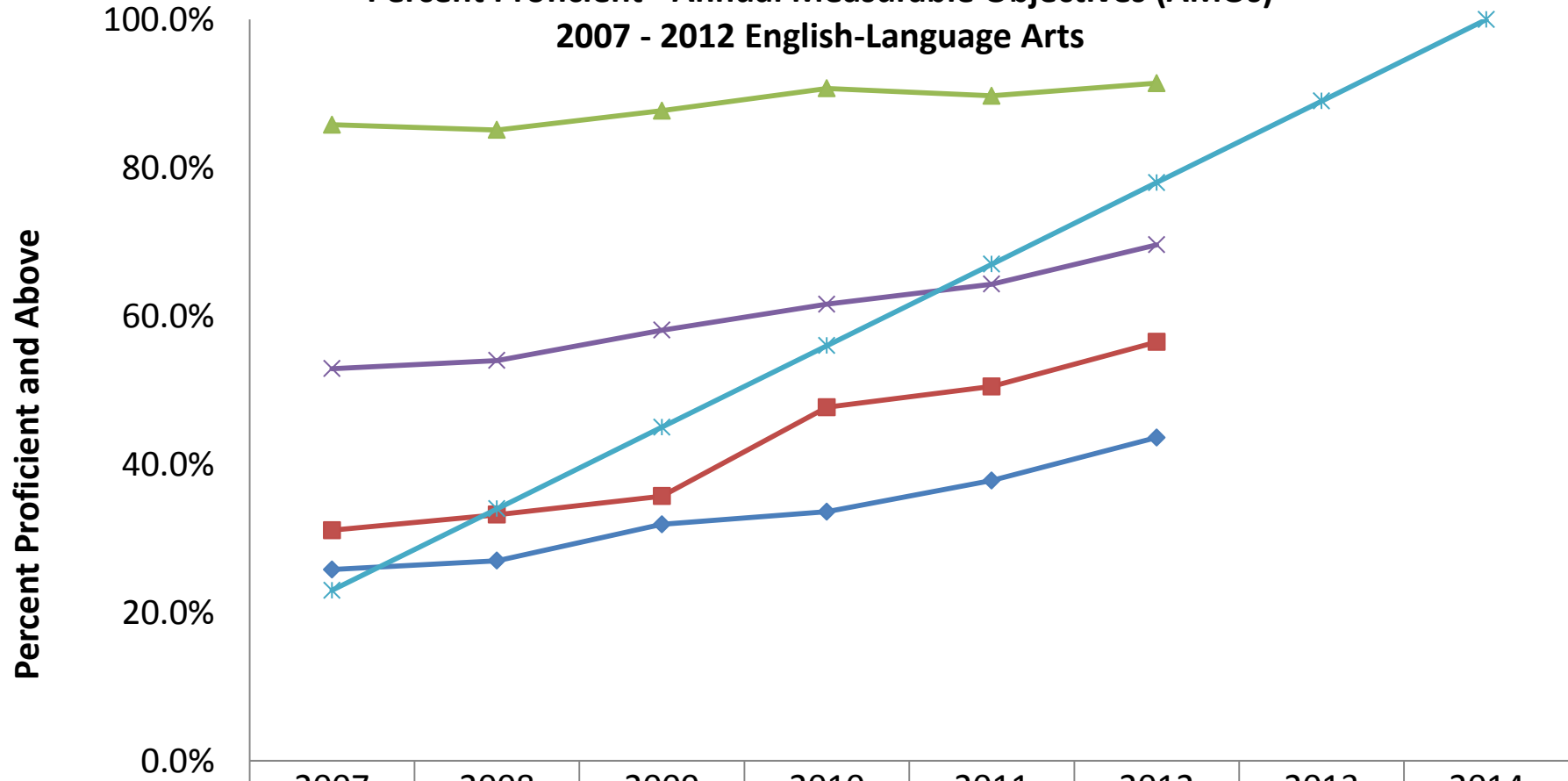

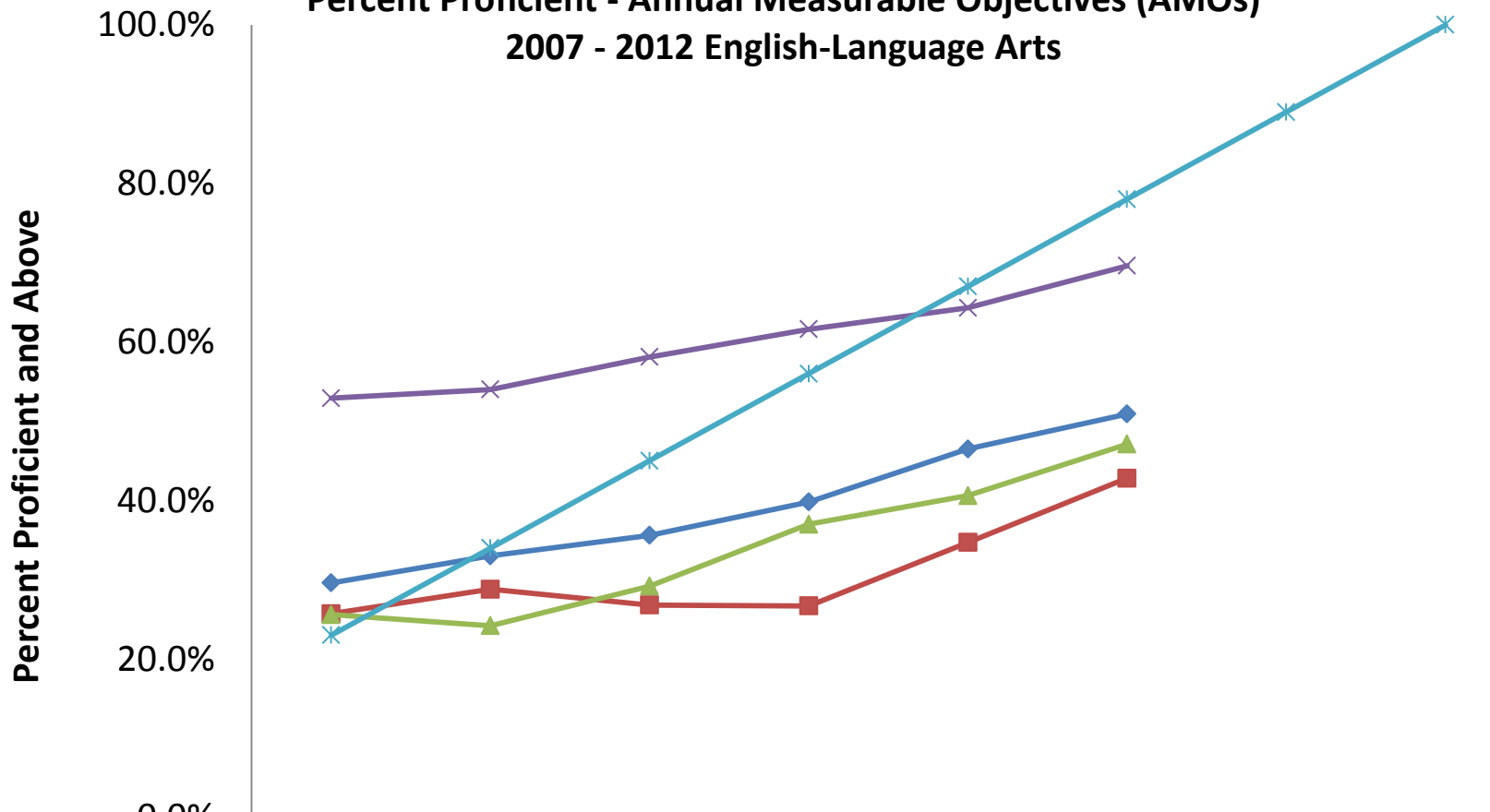

2007 - 2012 English-Language Arts**



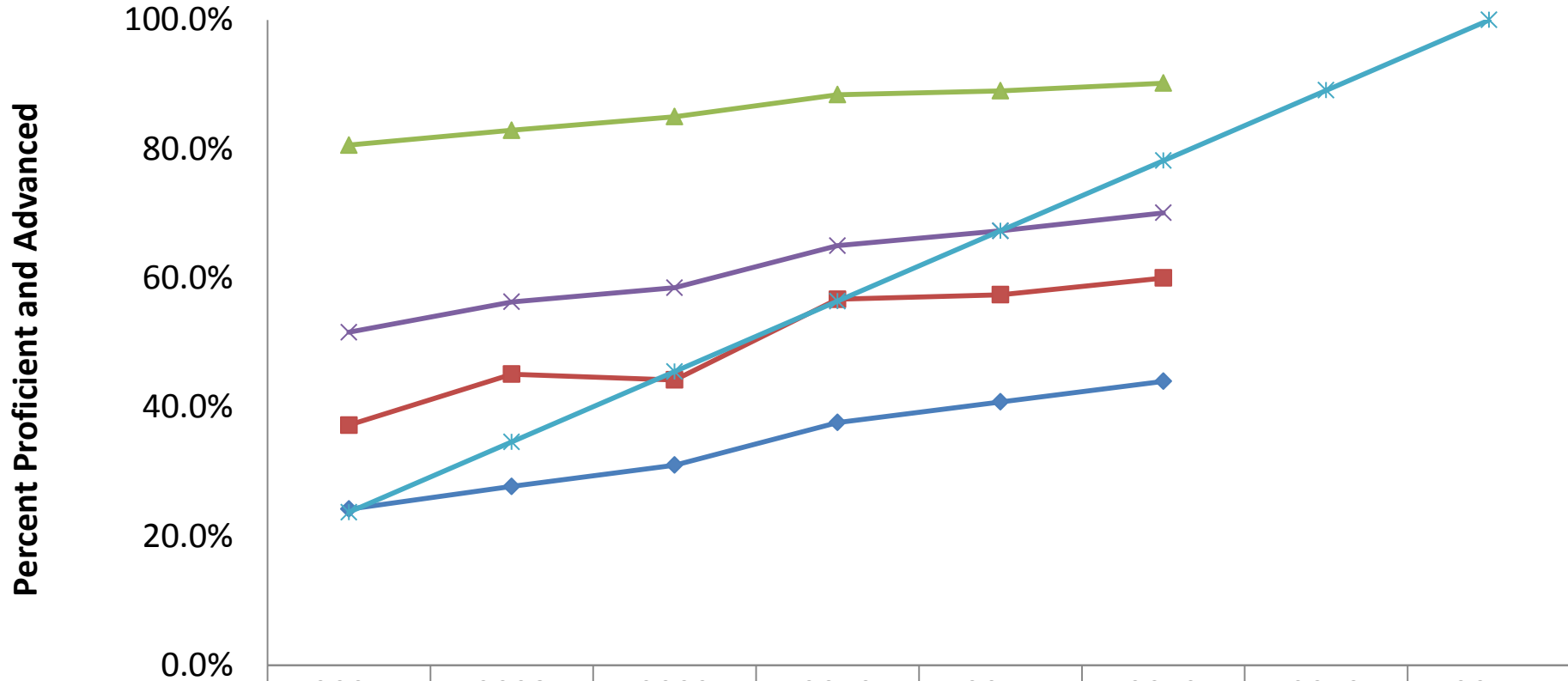

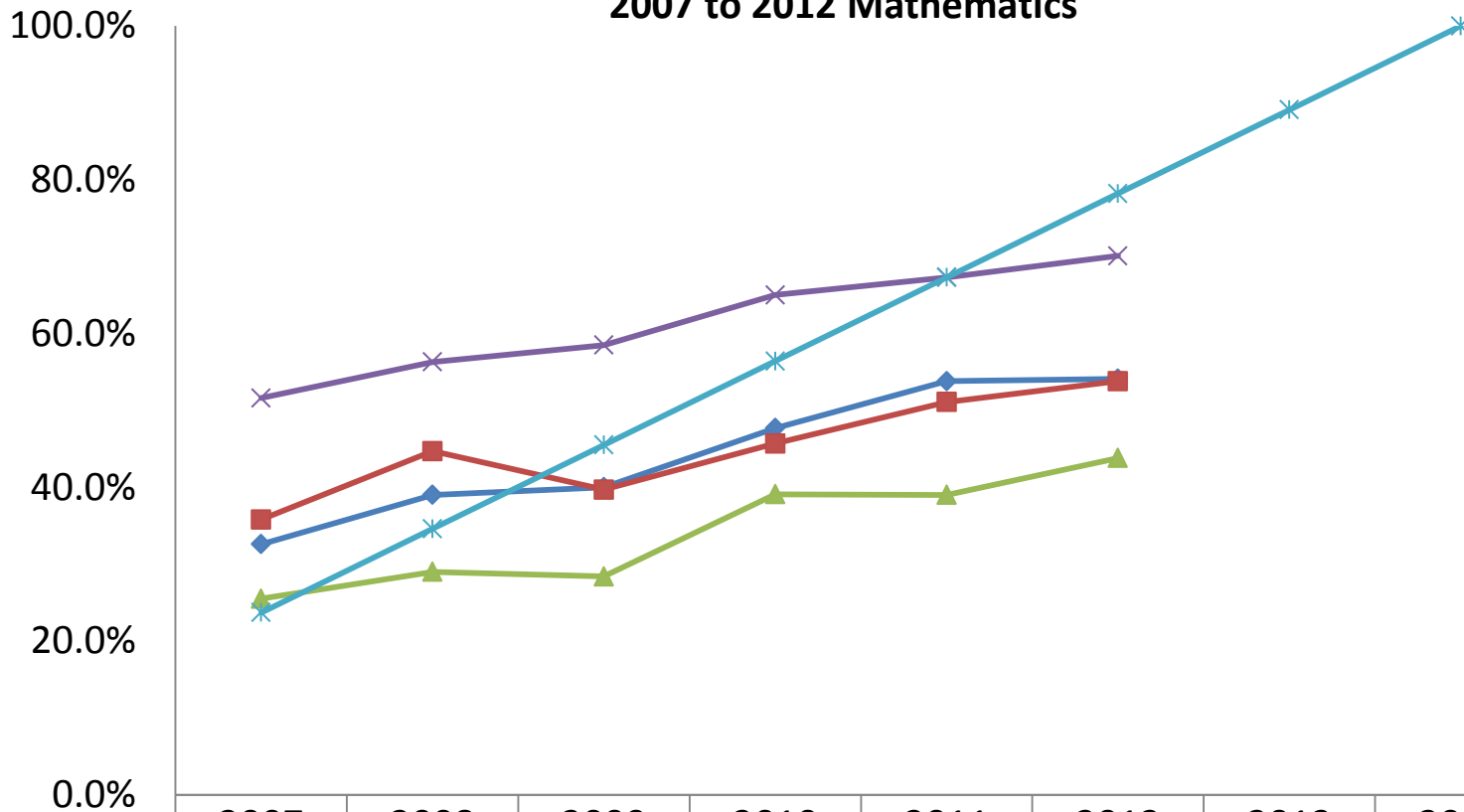

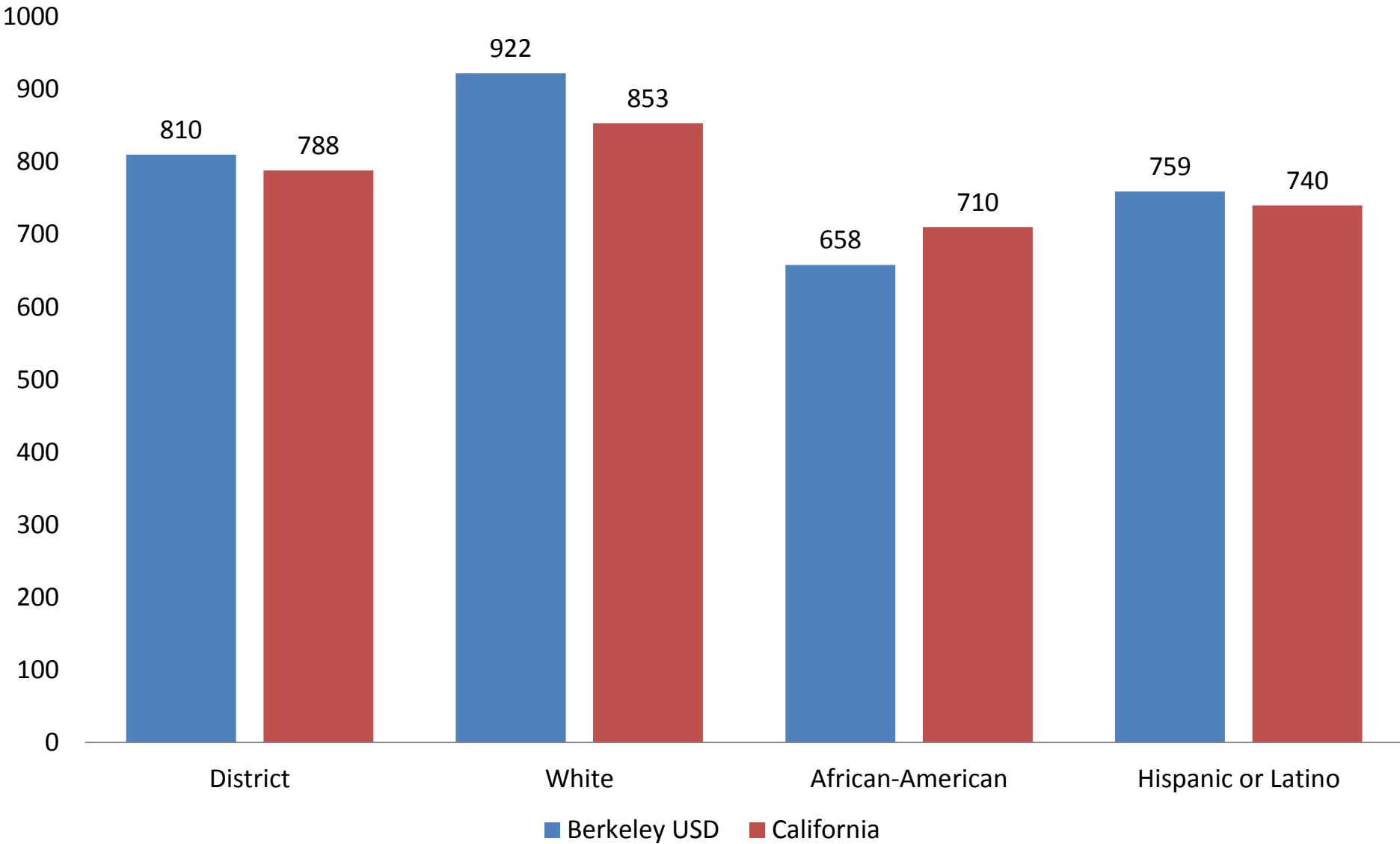

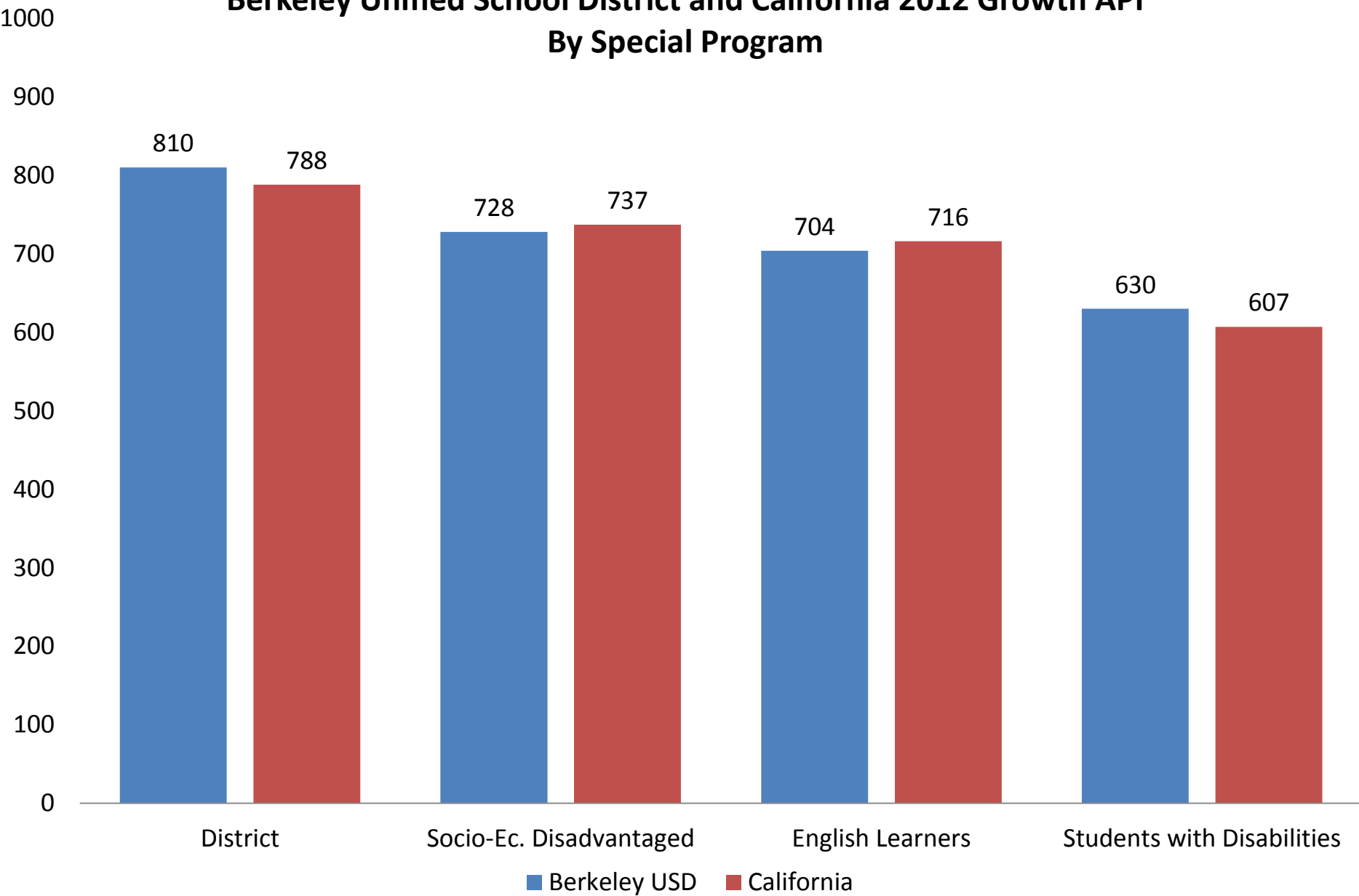

Berkeley Unified School District and California 2012 Growth API By Race / Ethnicity

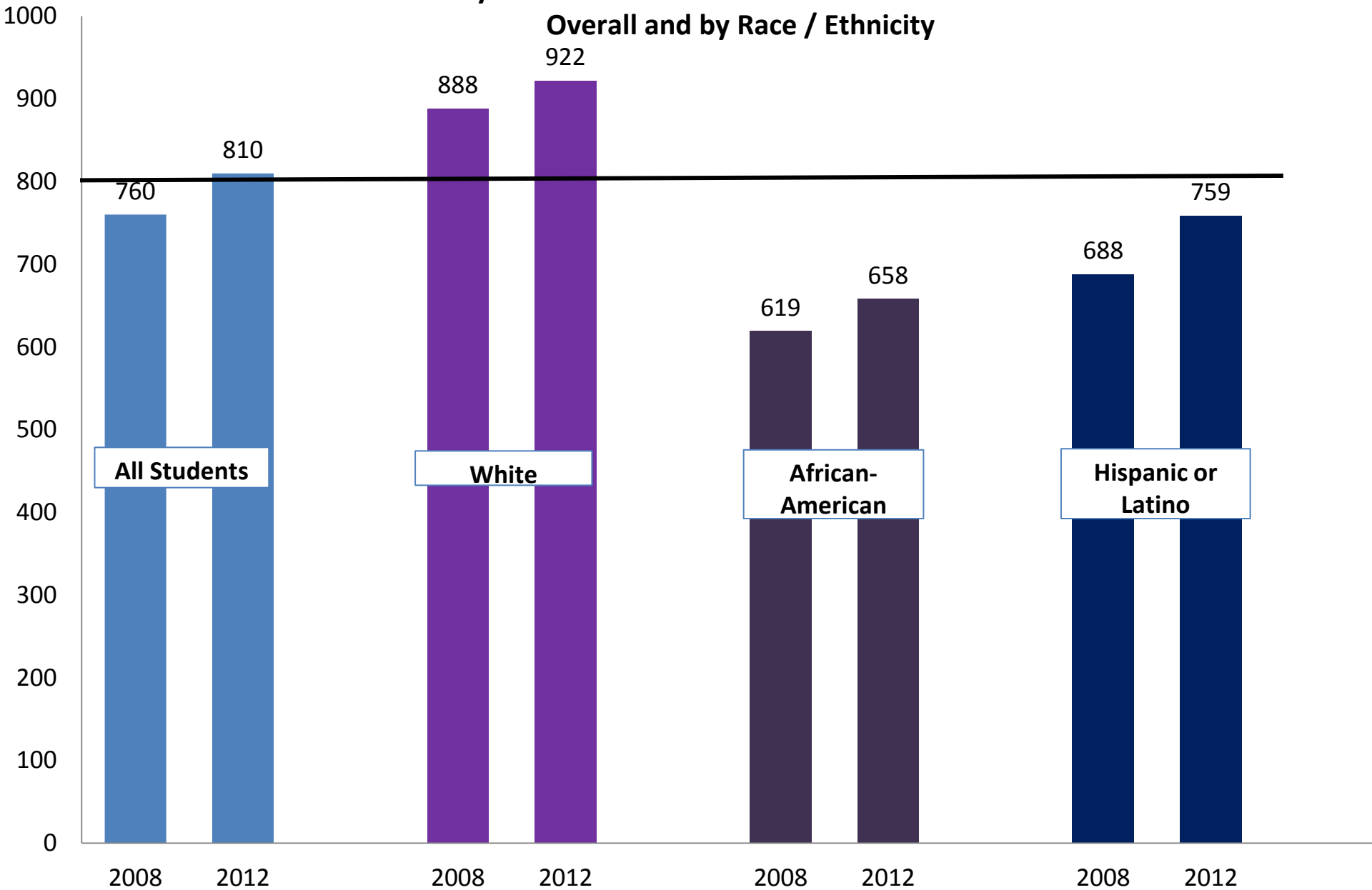


Berkeley Unified School District and California 2012 Growth API By Special Program

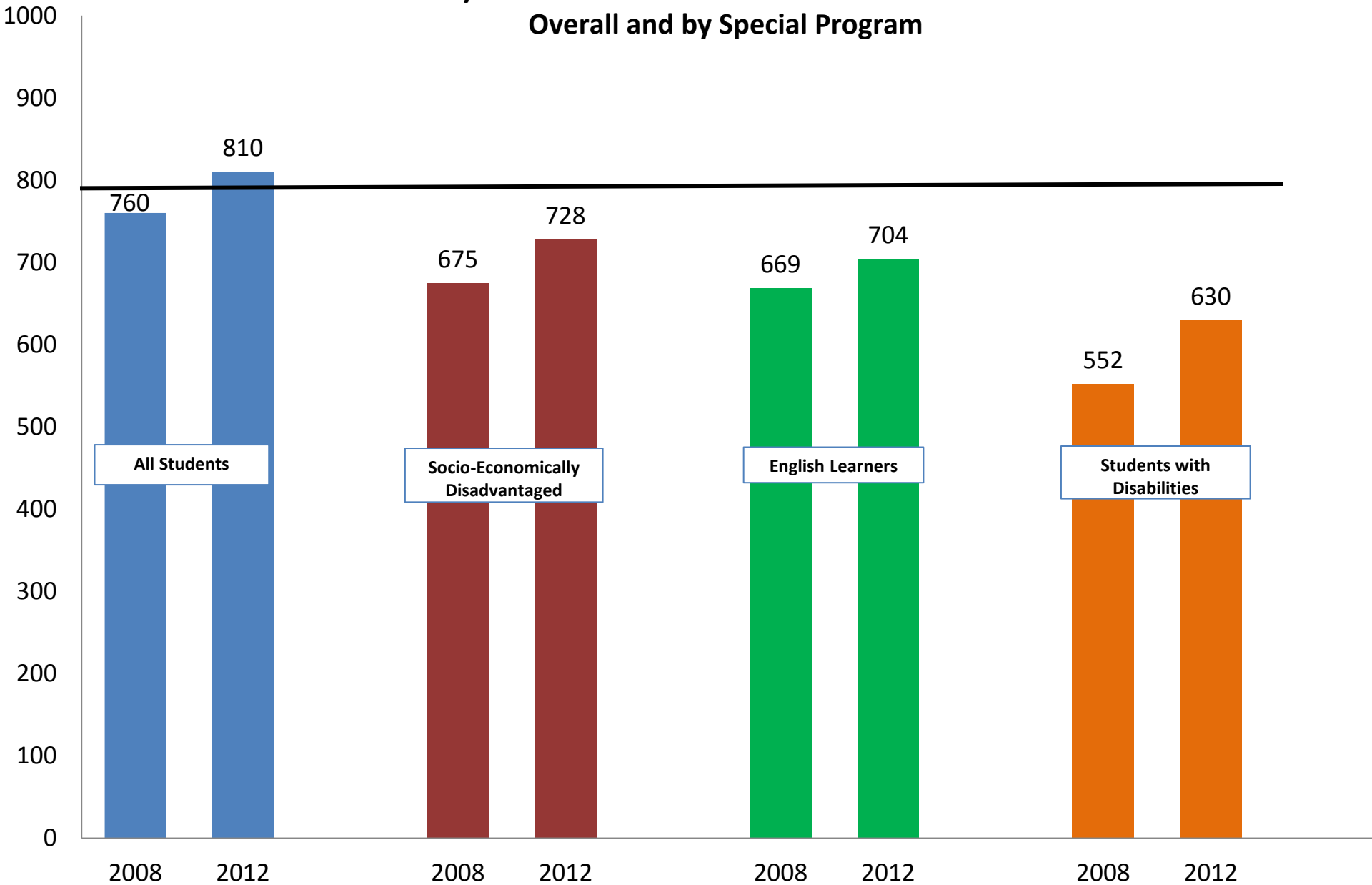


Berkeley Unified School District API 2008 to 2012 Growth

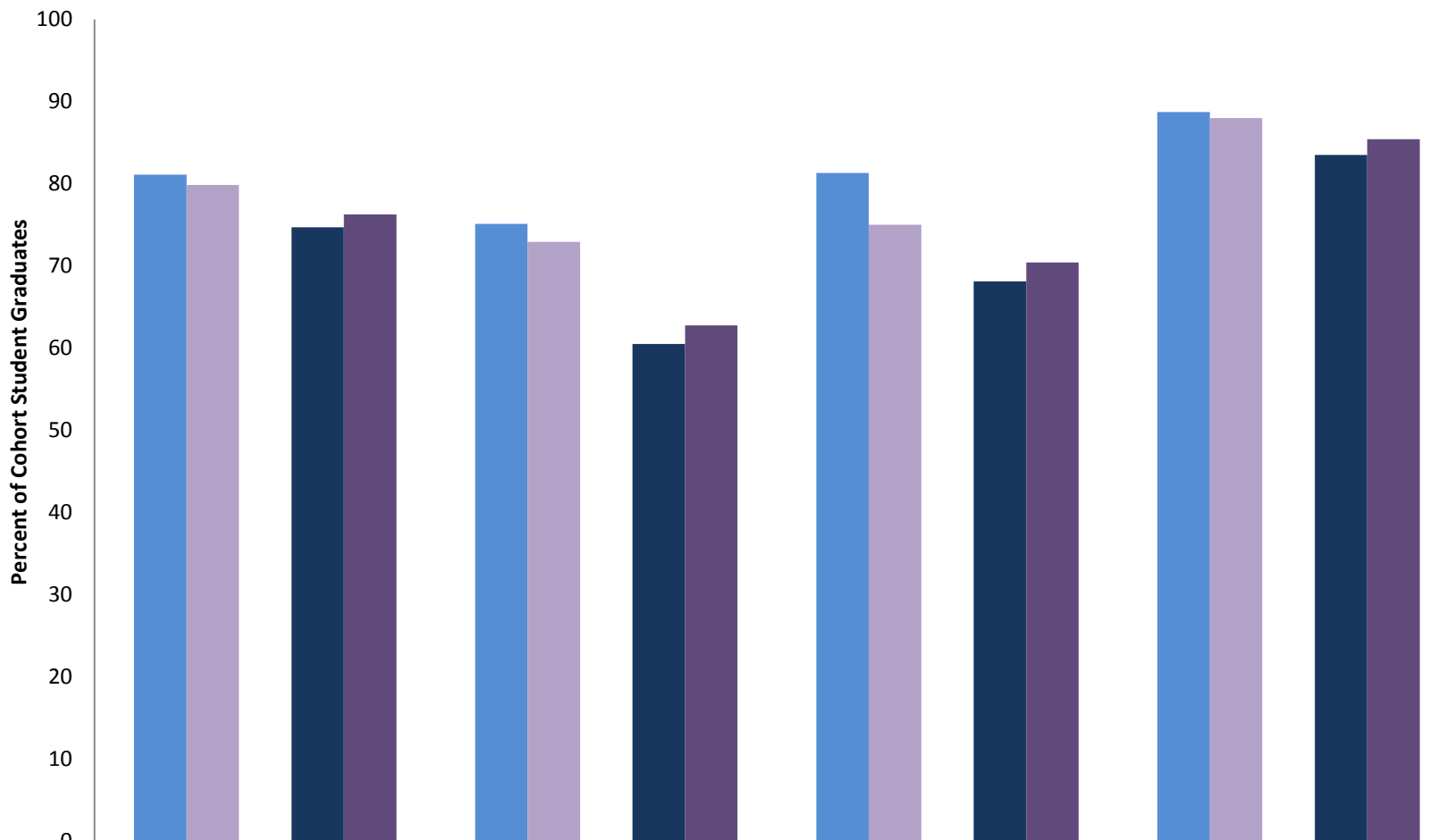
Overall and by Race / Ethnicity

Accountability Progress Report Take Aways

- Greater percentages of students in all of our targeted subgroups are scoring at proficient or advanced on the AYP.
- The district is making progress in closing the achievement gap between our African American and Latino students and their White peers on the AYP and API.
- BUSD exceeded the API state target of 800.
- All subgroups in BUSD made double digit gains on the API.
- For the second year in a row, Berkeley High School received an API with an increase of 19 points from the 2011 Base.
- BUSD students outperform the State overall whereas our African-American, English Learners and Socio-Economically Disadvantaged students are scoring lower than the state in Grades 9-11.
