### Discussion Conversation

Saddler: Reviewed handouts for LCAP proposals and encouraged questions about site proposals that could be answered by site representatives

Dafflon: P2 increases FTE at sites with highest caseload (BAM, SMES, WES, AND TOES)

P5 is only for students at AfrAm students at SMES

Saddler: P7 is a reco from Extended Learning Task Force for a summer reading program with a K-8 focus to avoid summer reading loss for unduplicated students in the Expanded Learning program. It's listed as K-12, but HS model has staffing challenges that will be addressed later.

Saddler: (P9) Is not common to use a contractor for math support. District is required to open opportunity to teachers before contracting out. Will not list contractor in recommendation to board. Impact on students is that they'll have to start at 7:30am and will not be able to participate in music. Will

present recommendation as 1) funding for zero period snaps support, 2) other sites have zero period 1-2 days p/week and 3) is a way for teachers to build connections with students.

PAC is first to look at the proposals and make recommendations to the board. Will be presented as PAC's choices; however, business services will look at the fiscal impact and may tweak numbers.
