

**Inter district Permit Information**

If you wish for your child to attend a Berkeley Unified public school for the 2020-21 school year and you do not reside in Berkeley, you must obtain an inter district permit from your current public school of residence. **There is no guarantee your permit will be approved by BUSD.**

The inter district permit is required for anyone living outside of Berkeley who wishes to attend a Berkeley school. **Even if the student has never attended a public school in their home district, the inter district permit must be approved by your district of residence before a request to attend a school in BUSD can be considered.**

**Steps for New Inter district permits:**

1. Complete an inter district permit form available from your home district. (Below is a short list of neighboring districts)
2. **Enroll in your home district to ensure your child has a school assignment** (in case BUSD is unable to approve your permit due to lack of space).
3. Provide permit to our office for review once approved by your district. We will begin accepting permits April 6, 2020. In addition to the approved permit you will need to submit **your student's birth certificate, most up to date transcript, attendance and discipline records (even if there are no entries), BUSD parent preference form and a copy of parent identification. If your student has an IEP, please provide a current copy to leave with the admissions office.**
4. We will begin to review permits late August after Berkeley residents have enrolled. **Keep in mind that in some cases notification could be as late as the last week in September after the start of the school year.**
5. If approved we will call to notify you; at that time, you will be given instructions for enrollment. BUSD retains the right to determine school assignment based on space availability.
6. If the inter district permit is approved by BUSD you will need to renew your permit each school year. It is an annual permit and must be on file for each school year. Continuing students will not receive a school assignment for the following school year if a permit is not received by the end of the current school year. The approval of the inter district permit is contingent on a student maintaining satisfactory standards of academic progress, behavior and attendance. The permit can be revoked at any time if these standards are not met.
