

### High School Summer School (by recommendation only)

Berkeley Unified School District will provide a variety of summer options to support **learning recovery** and provide **social-emotional learning**. Students who are recommended by school counselors are invited to enroll.

All **Extended School Year (ESY)** students are automatically enrolled. ESY qualification is determined by IEP teams. Curriculum will include:

English Language Development (ELD) is geared towards accelerating English language development of ELD 1/2 students.

**Credit Recovery** classes are open to current 11th grade students for remediation only, which means either to raise an existing grade from "D" or "F" in a class a student has already taken, or to make-up a missed grade-level class.

The **Senior Diploma** program may be recommended to current seniors short up to 15 credits for graduation.
