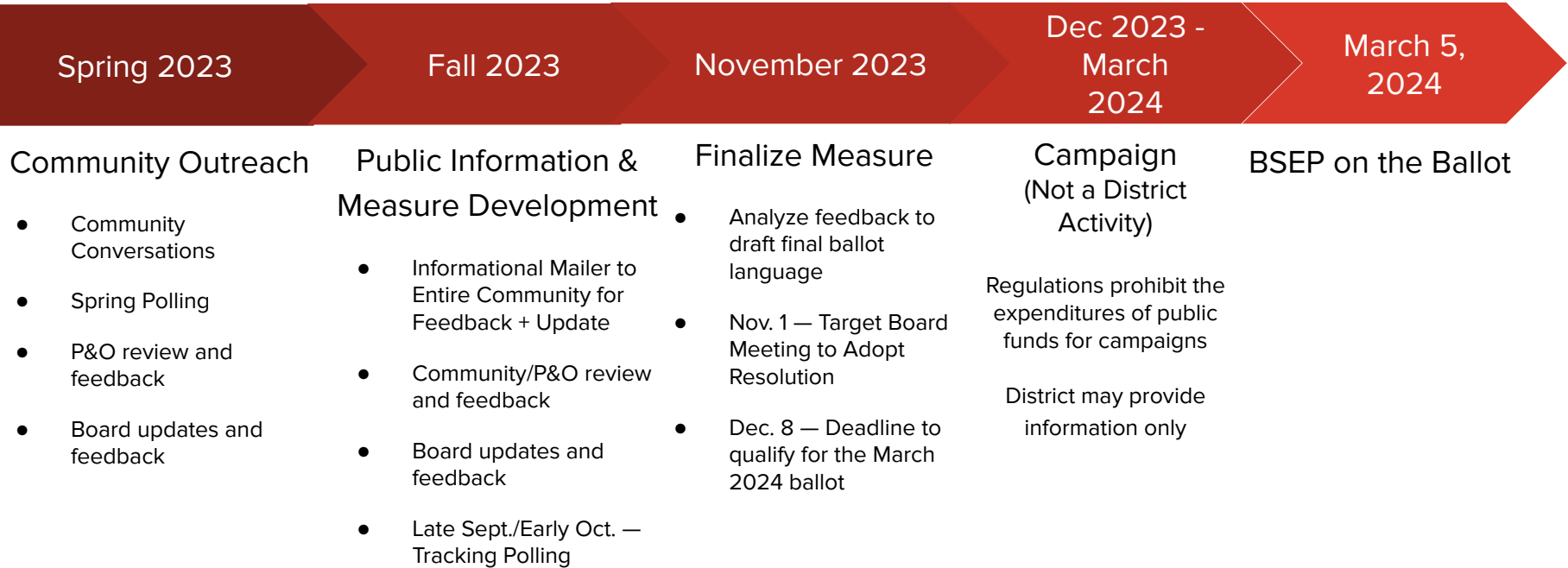

High Level Feedback:

- **Working well:** BSEP Oversight, Small Class Sizes, RTI, ECO, LEAP, U9, Libraries & librarians, Music
- **Questions/Improvements:**
 - How do we measure impact? Who measures it?
 - How does BSEP spending relate to total spending for district?
 - More counselors/OFEE/RTI staff, Professional Development options & strategies, evaluating services to focal populations



Voter Polling Results

Voters Highly Rate the District

BUSD Enjoys A Strong Rating

- 80% responded positively (of those who could rate the District)

BSEP Awareness Could Be Stronger, But It's Popular Amongst Those Who Know It

- 52% have heard of the BSEP
- 88% of those voters have a favorable opinion of BSEP

Commitment to Berkeley Public Schools

- 81% agree that paying “extra taxes to support our schools in Berkeley is something to be proud of”
- 85% agree that “If continuing these special taxes improves the quality of learning for Berkeley kids, then it is worth the cost”

 - Continued Community Conversations
 - Planning & Oversight Committee Feedback
 - Begin Drafting BSEP Ballot Measure Language
- **Sept — Fall Poll**
 - Assess final rate, duration and accountability provisions
 - Confirm community priorities for programs
- **Oct-Nov — Board Adoption**
 - Oct 15 — Board Meeting for Measure Review
 - Nov. 1 — Board Meeting for Measure Adoption
 - Dec. 8 — Deadline to Qualify for March 2024 Ballot

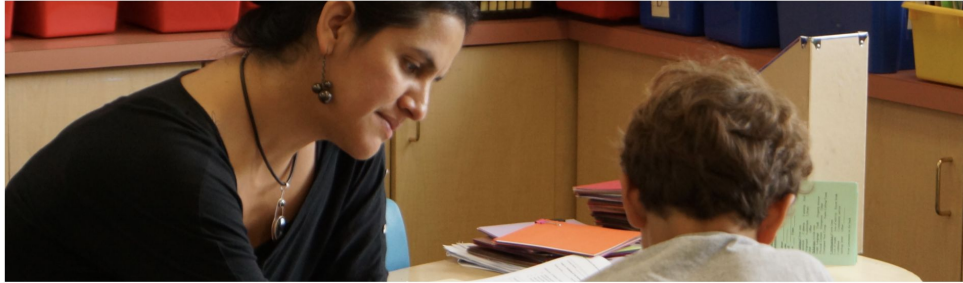
